Please read the following letter carefully as we are having to adjust our original syllabus.

Hello students and parents! We have missed each of you and hope you are safe. The AFM teachers have been working hard on a plan to resume learning new material on April 13th.Until then, remediation and optional work can be done. These opportunities were sent out via Remind and posted on our website: pchsafm.weebly.com. If you choose to do **remediation work**, it is **due by Friday April 3rd.** Until April 3rd, please use the resources on Delta Math to continue to practice and study. We encourage you to practice the previously taught material. We will start new material on April 13th after spring break.

Test Remediation:

You were given the option to complete any homework assignment in full, for full credit. If you did this, please remember that you should inform your teacher via email or Remind so that they know the update your grade. If you would like to remediate a past test grade (unit 1, unit 2A, and unit 2B), you must complete the test that is posted on CANVAS for that unit. As this is previously taught and tested material, you will have a time limit on the test. We will average your new test grade with your original test grade. If you are content with your current test grade, please know that this is not necessary.

Test Grades:

There will be NO remediation for tests moving forward, as they will be open note tests. All tests will be done on CANVAS and will have a time limit. We will announce dates as we progress.

Quiz Grades:

We will post quizzes on CANVAS for you to take. These will be timed, and we will announce dates as we progress.

Homework Grade:

This will not change. Delta Math assignments will still be posted for each unit and graded on the day of your test. We will, however, allow late credit on all homework. You will have until the end of the current quarter to earn up to 50% credit for the late homework.

Student Engagement:

Your teacher will be holding weekly question boards for student engagement credit on Google Classroom. You will be expected to post at least once per question board (if you don't have any questions, then state that in the question board).
