Tests

There are approximately 4-5 unit tests each quarter. The final exam will count as 20% of your total grade for AFM.

Ouizzes

There are 1-2 quizzes per unit. Attending at least 4 SMART lunches per quarter will add a 100 quiz grade for that quarter.

Remediation

Unit tests will have spiraled material from the previous unit. If a student scores higher on Test 2 than on Test 1, he/she will have the opportunity to average those grades together to replace the Test 1 grade IF he/she completes all test corrections (all work shown) for Test 1. This opportunity will happen for each test in quarter 1 and will start again in quarter 2. The last test of each quarter will not be able to be remediated.

Class Work/Homework

Class work will be done either with the textbook in class or with additional resources. Completing class work will allow you to earn up to five points on your Student Engagement sheet. On the following day, you may earn up to two points for the same assignment. Homework will consist of online assignments due at the end of each unit.

Student Engagement

You will be given a rubric with specific ways to earn up to 100 points. You will turn this in at the end of each quarter for your 5% Student Engagement grade. Points may not be carried over to the next quarter.

Grades

Grades are posted regularly online. Parents and students can access these grades through PowerSchool. Information on how to access PowerSchool is available through the main office.
