Tests

There are approximately four unit tests each quarter. The final exam will count as 20% of your total grade for AFM.

Quizzes

There are one to two quizzes per unit. If you attend at least 4 SMART lunches per nine weeks, your lowest quiz grade will be dropped.

Homework

Homework will be assigned nightly online. We will check for homework completion daily. On the following day, questions will be addressed in class. There will be one homework grade at the end of each unit in the form of a homework quiz. You should have all unit homework completed before the homework quiz. If you do not have nightly access, please let your teacher know in advance.

Student Engagement

You will be given a rubric with specific ways to earn up to 100 points. You will turn this in at the end of each quarter for your 5% Student Engagement grade. Points may not be carried over to the next quarter.

Warm-ups

During class each day we will start with a warm-up. Warm-ups are to be completed in the time allotted and may be collected weekly. If you are absent, you will be asked to write the date and the word "absent" in order to be exempt from that day's warm-up.

Grades

Grades are posted regularly online. Parents and students can access these grades through Powerschool. Information on how to access Powerschool is available through the main office.
